ALL NATIONS HERITAGE SUNDAY TODAY -- On the first Sunday of October each year, our denomination observes "All Nations Heritage." It's a reminder that, first of all, our denomination is an increasingly diverse and multicultural expression of the Kingdom of God. And it's also a reminder that we are part of a global movement of God, the church around the world. We celebrate that we are part of "*a great multitude from every nation*" (Rev 7:9).

SECOND OFFERING TODAY FOR WORLD RENEW DISASTER RESPONSE SERVICES: DRS is preparing to respond to Hurricane Helene, which has impacted 12 states in the southeastern U.S., from Florida to Virginia. Regional managers for DRS are connecting with our long-standing partners in the region. DRS reconstruction teams will offer long-term recovery groups in areas most affected by the storm, and additional volunteer clean-up teams and survey groups can be assigned as coordination progresses.



IN CELEBRATION OF THE LORD’S SUPPER NEXT SUNDAY, we invite you to a time of joyful, life-changing reflection in preparation for participating in communion.
